Dear Mendocino County Planning Commission,

The Mendocino City Community Services District is a small Special District in charge of groundwater management for the town of, and surrounding residents in Mendocino. MCCSD is very concerned with impacts of climate change on water resiliency. MCCSD understands the Planning Commission is in the process of reviewing an Ordinance recently supported by the Board of Supervisors to regulate groundwater sales and transport from private wells.

MCCSD is looking to improve our data collection on trucked water for planning purposes. It is difficult to plan for community water needs if we do not have accurate information on how much water is being imported into our District.

Our hope or request is that the Planning Commission include some language in this new County Ordinance which requires all water haulers to report every load to the County or District, where they purchase the water and where they deliver, even if purchasing from a municipality, water district, water company, private well, etc. We are less interested in the specific property receiving water as we are total gallons delivered or extracted within our boundaries, where that water is coming from, and if water is being delivered to residential or commercial addresses.
