Dear Mendocino County Grand Jury Members,

This correspondence is the Willits Police Department response to your Mendocino County Grand Jury Report of June 3, 2020 related to <u>School Safety-A Priority</u>. I have reviewed your Grand Jury Summary, Background, Discussion and Findings on this important topic, and we <u>concur</u> with your conclusions and findings relative to prioritizing school Safety. Pursuant to *California Penal Code 933.05*, your recommendations have been implemented by us. Student victimization, teen suicide rates and overall school safety concerns remain ongoing concerns of the Willits Police Department. We remain committed to school safety enhancements and continue to work in partnership with our schools as well as community-based groups, local, County, State and Federal agencies and first responders to prioritize school safety.

Due to fiscal realities currently experienced by both our City and our local schools, it has been necessary for our schools to temporarily suspend funding of our School Resource Officer (SRO) program, which was an important component of our school safety program. The additional challenge of the Covid-19 Health Crisis has further complicated our collective responses to school safety and identification of potential student mental health issues related to depression and suicide. The current 'shut down' of schools and our new reality of online student learning have created additional challenges. Despite the loss of our School Resource Officer position, the Willits Police Department has been awarded a new Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS) grant by the Department of Justice (DOJ). This newly funded police officer position will assist us in enhancing community education and outreach, and will serve as our school safety liaison until such time as the School Resource Officer (SRO) position is restored. We will continue school emergency response education and training for students and faculty on "active shooter" and related student safety issues. We remain in contact with our school officials, and the

Willits Police Department's response times to schools is well below acceptable required response times. On any given weekday we a deploy a maximum of three (3) officers on day shift, but work in close partnership with the Mendocino County Sheriffs to augment our response to critical incidents.

We appreciate the opportunity to participate in prioritizing school safety here in the City of Willits and in Mendocino County. Should you require additional information, please contact Lieutenant Derek Hendry at (707) 459-6122.
