Measure B Current Projects and Status December 2021

Crisis Residential Treatment Facility – Construction is predominantly complete, pending a few items delayed by COVID supply chain issues. Fence staining and generator installation are the predominant remaining items. The operator is progressing with pre-licensing activities. The CHFFA grant award was able to be extended to early spring. The Grand Opening is set for Thursday, December 16, 2021 from 2:30 – 4:30 PM.







The Crisis Residential Treatment Facility will provide an eight bed, short term mental health facility within Mendocino County to serve individuals who are experiencing an acute psychiatric crisis.

Mobile Crisis Response Team Pilot - We are excited to announce that our second Mental Health Rehabilitation specialist has been hired, and is in the onboarding & orientation process. Training with MCSO and UPD will begin soon. The second MHRS allows us to expand coverage to Mobile Response to seven days a week inland. We continue to recruit for the final MHRS. We are hopeful that we will be successful in securing grant funding to expand this project.

Community Education, Awareness, and Support - Behavioral Health and Recovery Services issued a Request for Qualification for a potential Operator on April 12, 2021. National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) Mendocino was the winning bidder. The contract with NAMI Mendocino was approved by the Board of Supervisors on August 31, 2021. NAMI and BHRS are preparing to conduct a public education campaign regarding suicide prevention using yard signs. NAMI is also working on trainings for the general public on how to manage encounters with people with a mental illness, and is meeting with Native American Community members regarding education, anti-stigma, and best ways to serve their population. Executive Director recruitment update: NAMI is getting ready for the final round of interviews.



Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee Behavioral Health Director's Report



Behavioral Health Regional Training Center - The first training was held at the center in early December. MCSO hosted a Crisis Intervention Team training. MCSO corrections and patrol staff were trained in addition to the two Mobile Crisis Response MHRS staff and a Measure B Committee member.

Psychiatric Health Facility - Behavioral Health and Recovery Services issued a Request for Qualification for a potential Operator on September 1, 2020. A notice of conditional acceptance was sent to the selected contractor Telecare Corporation. Nacht & Lewis have been working with the County, AECOM, and Telecare as they complete their feasibility study of the facility on Whitmore Lane. Feasibility study is in the final stages and is planned to be presented to the Board of Supervisors late January or early February 2022.

Crisis Assessment and Psychiatric Hospitalization Aftercare – Redwood Community Crisis Center started providing crisis assessment and psychiatric hospitalization aftercare to the community on July 1, 2021. These services are provided to individuals within the community that do not have Medi-Cal as their health insurance provider.

Mental Health Treatment Act Audit - An auditor has been selected to examine management's assertion that the entity complied with the expenditure restrictions as described in Chapter 5.180 of the Mendocino County Code entitled the "Mental Health Treatment Act" during each of the periods July 1, 2019, to June 30, 2020, July 1, 2020, to June 30, 2021, and July 1, 2021, to June 30. The audits are expected to be completed by March 31, 2022.
