RESOLUTION OF THE MENDOCINO COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT ACT CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE AUTHORIZING REMOTE TELECONFERENCE MEETINGS OF THE LEGISLATIVE BODIES OF THE MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT ACT CITIZENS OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE PURSUANT TO THE RALPH M. BROWN ACT

WHEREAS, all meetings of the **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** and its legislative bodies are open and public, as required by the Ralph M. Brown Act (Cal. Gov. Code §§ 54950 – 54963), so that any member of the public may attend, participate, and view the legislative bodies conduct their business; and

WHEREAS, the Brown Act, Government Code section 54953(e), makes provisions for remote teleconferencing participation in meetings by members of a legislative body, without compliance with the requirements of Government Code section 54953(b)(3), subject to the existence of certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, on March 4, 2020, Governor Newsom issued a Proclamation of a State of Emergency declaring a state of emergency exists due to the outbreak of respiratory illness due to a novel coronavirus (a disease now known as COVID-19), pursuant to the California Emergency Services Act (Government Code section 8625) and that State of Emergency is still in effect in the State of California; and,

WHEREAS, as of the date of this Resolution, neither the Governor nor the state Legislature have exercised their respective powers pursuant to Government Code section 8629 to lift the state of emergency either by proclamation or by concurrent resolution the state Legislature; and,

WHEREAS, the California Department of Industrial Relations has issued regulations related to COVID-19 Prevention for employees and places of employment. Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 3205(c)(5)(D) specifically recommends physical (social) distancing as one of the measures to decrease the spread of COVID-19 based on the fact that particles containing the virus can travel more than six feet, especially indoors; and,

WHEREAS, the Mendocino County Public Health Officer continues to recommend teleconferencing during public meetings of all legislative bodies to protect the community's health against the spread of COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** finds that state or local officials have imposed or recommended measures to promote social distancing based on the Mendocino County Public Health Officer recommendation and the California Department of Industrial Relations' issuance of regulations related to COVID-19 Prevention through Title 8 of the California Code of Regulations, Section 3205(c)(5)(D); and,

WHEREAS, as a consequence, the **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** does hereby find that current conditions meet the circumstances set for in Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to allow this legislative body to conduct its meetings by teleconferencing without compliance with Government Code section 54953 (b)(3), pursuant to Section 54953(e), and that such legislative body shall comply with the requirements to provide the public with access to the meetings as prescribed by Government Code section 54953(e)(2) to ensure the public can safely participate in and observe local government meetings. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Recitals</u>. All of the above recitals are true and correct and are incorporated into this Resolution by this reference.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Current Conditions Authorize Teleconference Public Meetings of Legislative</u> <u>Bodies</u>. Based on the California Governor's continued declaration of a State of Emergency, the Mendocino County Public Health Officer's recommendation to continue teleconferencing, and the regulations issued by the California Department of Industrial Relations, the **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** finds that the conditions continue to exist pursuant to Government Code section 54953(e)(3) to allow legislative bodies to use teleconferencing to hold public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(2) to ensure members of the public have continued access to safely observe and participate in local government meetings.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Remote Teleconference Meetings</u>. The **Mental Health Treatment Act Citizens Oversight Committee** is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Resolution including, conducting open and public meetings in accordance with Government Code section 54953(e)(2) and other applicable provisions of the Brown Act.

<u>Section 4</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

3d) Update and Discussion Regarding Measure B Related Items at the Board of Supervisors Meetings.

Presenter: Chair Miller

- No items or recent presentations at the BOS meetings.
- Items slated for July at BOS: capital facilities reserve, update on total cost for the CRT, and an update on the PHF.

Committee Action: None.

3e) Update and Discussion Regarding the Status of Current Measure B Projects.

Presenter: Chair Miller

- Report provided to all attendees and included in agenda packet.
- Member Allman requested the Fort Bragg Crisis Respite project be included in the monthly report going forward.

Public Comments: Regarding the partnership between crisis workers and the UPD and Sheriff's department. Through the Dual Response model, crisis workers team up with law enforcement and go out to calls when there is a call that law enforcement believes needs a mental health response.

Committee Action: None.

3f) Update and Discussion Regarding the Sheriff Substation.

Presenter: Member Riley

• Member Allman reported that a water leak ruined the wooden floor, and there is currently a delay with the insurance provider to repair. Member Allman commented that Measure B funds should not be used for anything that belongs to the Sheriff's department. Member Allman will update this Committee when/if there are any updates.

Committee Action: None.

3g) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Expenditure Plan Format presented by County staff for the June 22, 2022 meeting.

Presenter: Member Ebyam

• Discussion on items omitted from Member Ebyam's report on the county fiscal report (please refer to item agenda summary).

Public Comment:

 Jannelle Rau, General Services Agency Director: regarding capital improvements and capital asset management. Ms. Rau explained that the entire cost of a project is capitalized, which includes design and architecture. There are guidelines on whether that adds or improves the life of the asset, and if it does, those services (whether hard or soft) are part of the capital project. Regarding billing, it would be difficult to provide a monthly report on the status. Facilities staff manage the project as a whole; they do a reconcialiton of the project (typically at project conclusion) and then have a complete accounting of entire labor, service, material, etc.

 Tom Housky: Regarding concern about staffing the facilities being built, and where does ongoing funding come from to keep the facilities operational not just 5 years from now. Would like this Committee to take into conseiration what should happen after the facilities are built, and after the 5 years.

Committee Action: Upon motion by Member Ebyam seconded by Member Allman it is ORDERED that the fiscal items identified by Member Ebyam (separation of budgeted and actual costs for capital costs from budgeted and actual costs for operational costs, annual ongoing costs after expected reibursements, other projects under consideration and their projected costs, reconcialiation of expenses from county reports with plan expenses) be included in the county fiscal report going forward with Member Ebyam continuing to work with county staff.

- Motion passes with 7 approvals.
- 3h) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding Annual Maintenance Cost, Building Life Cycle Cost, and Capital Facilities Reserve for the Regional Training Center, Crisis Residential Treatment Facility, and Psychiatric Health Facility Buildings.

Presenter: Member Antle

- Discussion regarding whether or not this Committee would like to look into a capital facility reserve for long term maintenance of the buildings.
- Janelle Rau: The county has been assessing county owned property, and GSA has assessed the BHRTC (i.e. what is the capital annual or 5 year increment investment that should be planned for) it is a draft. Type of use (parking lot, what is the type of use, daily use) to identify a realistic share of cost. Space and condition assessment is pending. This is a planning tool, not a budgeting tool. Once GSA has a more solid document of this assessment, it will be shared with this Committee. Ms. Rau explained that these numbers can be ran annualy to have estimates for each year to have better knowledge and come up with better estimates to set aside the appropriate funds. Increase in costs in materials, 30-50% increase have impacted estimates from a couple years ago.
- Ms. Rau explained that her role as the General Services Agency Director is to be transparent on cost of ownership for each county asset. The BOS over the last years has chosen to differ preventative maintenance and capital maintenance reserve, but the county does have an obligation to maintain every facility. Behavioral Health will not be able to maintain the capital facility costs of these buildings.
- Follow up at the next Committee once General Services has a more accurate report of the BHRTC assessment.

Committee Action: None.

3i) Discussion and Consideration Regarding Funding Request from Ford Street Project for Expansion of the Ukiah Recovery Center.

Presenter: Member Riley

- Funding request plan included in agenda packet.
- Member Riley proposed partial Measure B funds, partial City of Ukiah funds, and partial County Opiod settlement funds for this request.
- Item to be included on the next meeting agenda with more details and additional

information.

Public Comment:

- Libby Guthrie, MCAVHN Executive Director: regarding the lack of integration of care in this county. Would like to see an expansion of services in a facility that addresses both SUD and mental health disorders. Would like this committee to consider the expansion of any treatment service facility in this county to include a facility that will address both SUD and MH disorders concurrently.
- Val Tecas: Has been working in ER's for about 50 years; there are no detox beds in the county, but 80% of SUD clients also have a mental illness. As a nurse, she is always needing to send clients out of the county to receive treatment. Is opposed to using Measure B funds for a facility that does not treat psychiatric patients.
- Jessica Johnson: Co-occuring disorders are our population's biggest issue and the impacts it has on the individual and the county. Regarding the lack of a co-occurring dual diagnosis treatment facility leaving a large gap in services for some of Mendocino County's most vulnerable residents. Ford Street does not treat co-occurung disorder oatuents and is not the appropriate serive provider as this would be a misuse in Measure B funding. Would like this committee to consider an integrated facility that aligns with the intention and purpose of Measure B.
- Jill Ales, Mendocino County SUDT Program and Services Manager: Would like to see how the County can put money forward to treat all individuals regardless of what their diagnosis is (mental health or SUD).

Committee Action: None.

3 <u>COMMITTEE MATTERS</u>

3a) Discussion and Possible Action Regarding the Measure B Mendocino County Grand Jury Report.

- Chair Miller will be using the committee's responses as her official response to the Grand Jury report.
- **Finding 1**: The wording of the Measure B ordinance was very precise on the collection of the taxes. The ordinance was impressive about the execution of the programs. There is insufficient organizational direction in the Measure B Ordinance. This has resulted in a lack of ground rules for discussion and making recommendations to the BOS.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: Recommendation to BOS to develop a policy that gives County Counsel more clarity and oversight in reviewing potential ballot initiatives.

• **Finding 2**: In the Measure B Ordinance, the responsibilities of the B Committee were unclear, resulting in members assuming authority which belonged to the BOS.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: Recommendation to BOS to develop a policy that gives County Counsel more clarity and oversight in reviewing potential ballot initiatives.

• **Finding 3**: There has been no direct funding for SUDT as recommended in the Measure B Ordinance and the Kemper Report. The GJ determined this to be a serious oversight.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: Upon motion by Member Riley, seconded by Member Allman it is ORDERED that the Measure B Committee agree with Finding 3.

- All in favor, motion carried.
- **Finding 4:** A required function of the B Committee is to review annual audits and to ensure transparent use of funds. Annual independent audits of taxpayers' money were not performed resulting in no definitive answer to what funds are available or have been expended.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: Committee partially disagrees. An audit was not performed (until 2022), but there are financial reports provided monthly. Public comments:

- Jo Bradley: This was not an intentional oversight as things have not been running normal, lack of fiscal staff due to pandemic.
- **Finding 5**: The first 15 months of operations are excluded from the commissioned audits. Not starting from day one does not give a complete financial picture.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: Although the first 15 months were excluded, there is a current audit plan in progress.

• **Finding 6**: The high vacancy rate of County employees, particularly for social service workers and nursing staff, has raised concern. Contractors for staffing the new programs and facilities may have difficulty employing sufficient local staff. This problem plagued the previous PHF facility which led to its closure.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: The previous PHF in Mendocino County did not close specifically due to not having sufficient staff.

• **Finding 7**: The GJ and service providers are concerned that SUDT programs will not receive adequate attention and funding under Measure B.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: Upon motion Member Riley, seconded by Member Allman it is ORDERED that the Measure B Committee respond to Finding 7 as follows: The committee agrees with the finding. The committee agrees that the grand jury and service providers have expressed concern for this matter; this matter is on the agenda for a future Measure B meeting.

• All in favor; motion passes.

• **Finding 8**: The GJ is concerned that the high costs to construct the PFH facility may reduce funds available for other proposed services and programs.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: Upon motion by Member Riley, seconded by Member Allman it is ORDERED that the Measure B Committee respond to Finding 8 as follows: The committee agrees with Finding 8. The committee notes that construction of the PHF is in process and staff and committee are closely monitoring expenses. In addition, the PHF is in original language of Measure B.

- All in favor; motion passes.
- **Recommendation 1**: in future ordinances prepared for ballot measures, the function and responsibility of County Departments, Advisory Boards and Committees be spelled out in greater detail.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond). Committee comments: Recommendation for County Counsel to review and verify all requirements are met.

• **Recommendation 2**: the BOS fund SUDT programs as required by Measure B Ordinance No. 4387.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: Upon motion Member Riley seconded by Member Ebyam is it ORDERED that the Measure B committee respond to recommendation 2 as follows: This recommendation requires further analysis. The Measure B oversight committee will provide additional explanation within the next 3 months regarding the future agendized discussions on this matter.

- All in favor; motion passes.
- **Recommendation 3**: the County Auditor ensures annual independent audits be conducted of Measure B funds as required, commencing with the initial funding of the measure and to include election and consultant costs.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: None (committee not required to respond).

• **Recommendation 4**: the BOS give direction to staff to identify and pursue additional funding to supplement the Measure B one-eighth cent sales tax by applying for grants and State funding.

<u>Committee Action/Response</u>: Upon motion by Member Riley, seconded by Member Allman it is ORDERED that the Measure B Committee respond to recommendation 4 as follows: The recommendation has been implemented and will continue to be implemented. The Committee has recommended and Board of Supervisors have

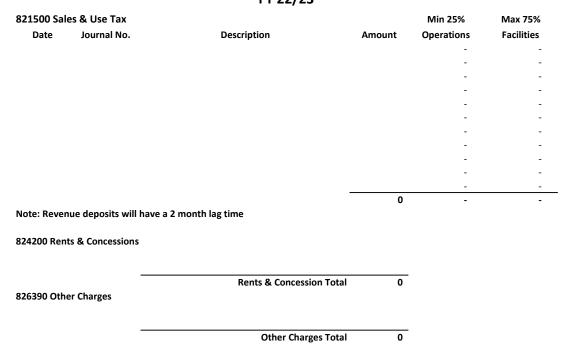

Community Education, Awareness, and Support - NAMI has collaborated with Mendocino County Behavioral Health, Pinoleville Pomo Nation and Consolidated Tribal Health for Suicide Prevention Month in September to bring related events throughout the County each week. Events included "Pathway to Healing" memorial vigils in Fort Bragg and Ukiah, public speakers and in-school education, and a Suicide Awareness Walk. Collectively, we shared the common goals of raising awareness, battling stigma, and promoting community healing through recognizing lives lost to suicide in our County. Our successful collaboration will continue into the month of October for National Substance Abuse Prevention Month, where we intend to facilitate celebrations of life for those lives lost to overdose in Mendocino County. With inclusivity in mind, we intend to travel to a different County community every Saturday, including Gualala, Anderson Valley, Willits, Fort Bragg, and Ukiah. Outside of these special events, NAMI continues to look at ways to build capacity by expanding access to our support groups and education programs.

Crisis Assessment and Psychiatric Hospitalization Aftercare: Measure B funding continues to provide a pathway for individuals who historically have not had access to crisis after care services reaching parity for non-Medi-Cal recipients.

SUMMARY OF REQUEST / BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

On June 23, 2020 the Board of Supervisors approved the "establishment of a prudent reserve of Measure B funds and to transfer 6.85% of the balance of Measure B funds into the prudent reserve on June 30th of each fiscal year for Measure B facilities and services as recommended by the Measure B Kemper Ad Hoc committee."

In light of this, \$3,090,916 was transferred for 19/20 and 20/21 and \$2,171,450 was estimated for 21/22 for a total prudent reserve of \$5,262,066.

Note: Since Measure B funding has greatly outpaced expenditures, the balance of Measure B funds still includes revenue from 18/19. Thus, revenue from 18/19 is included as part of the fund balance year after year and 6.85% of some of that revenue is put into the prudent reserve year after year even though it is revenue that was received one time. The same is true for revenue received in the years after 18/19.

The Kemper Report recommended "creating a Prudent Reserve that is carried forward into years 6-10 of the initiative, when the rate of sales tax collections drops from ½-cent to 1/8 cent." The calculation used in the Kemper report multiplies projected total Measure B revenue by the percent used in the report, which is 20.7%. Using that percent, the projected reserve would be 20.7% of total projected revenues of \$48,674,928 or \$10,075,710.

SUMMARY OF REQUEST / BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

At the June 22, 2022 meeting, the Measure B Committee received a brief presentation regarding the Ford Street Program's proposal to expand their substance abuse treatment facility. Following the discussion, the item was recommended for further discussion between the Board of Supervisors.

Since that time, the Board of Supervisors has referred the item back to the Measure B Committee for additional discussion. Committee member Riley is requesting discussion and direction regarding the following items:

Determination regarding the use of Measure B funds for Substance Abuse Disorder Treatment (SUDT): The original text of Measure B (Ordinance 4387) states that: "...this Ordinance is adopted to achieve the following, among other purposes, and directs that the provisions herein be interpreted in order to accomplish these purposes: ...Provide for the necessary infrastructure to support and stabilize individuals with behavioral health conditions, including addiction and neurological disorders." The Kemper Report supported that directive with the recommendation that 25% of Measure B funds be devoted to Substance Abuse Disorder Treatment (SUDT). However, at the June 22 meeting, discussion ensued that implied that Measure B funds could only be used for clients who had a dual diagnosis of addiction and mental health. Member Riley recommends a determination from the Committee that the treatment of addiction, with or without a co-existing diagnosis of mental illness, is an eligible use of Measure B funds.

<u>Commitment to the allocation of Measure B funds for SUDT</u>: In 2018, Kemper Consulting was hired to develop a "needs assessment" related to the mental health system in Mendocino County.

That report included a recommendation for additional Substance Use Disorder (SUD) treatment services in the region. Specifically, the report stated that, "We find key services are missing, most notably community-based recovery and rehabilitation programs and a wide range of residential treatment options..." Further, the 6/1/22 Mendocino County Grand Jury Report titled "Measure B Re-Examined" includes the following finding: "There has been no direct funding for SUDT as recommended in the Measure B Ordinance and the Kemper Report. The GJ determined this to be a serious oversight;" as well as the following recommendation: The BOS fund SUDT programs as required by Measure B Ordinance No. 4387. Therefore, Member Riley recommends that the Measure B Committee reaffirm its commitment to allocating funds for SUDT.

<u>Consideration of funding request from Ford Street Project</u>: Before the Measure B Committee is a request for funding from the Ford Street Project, the SUDT center in Ukiah that has been providing withdrawal management, outpatient treatment, residential treatment services, and a sober living environment since 2015. Attachment 1 outlines the request and provides additional information about the project, which would significantly increase the number of people who could be served by the project. Member Riley recommends support of this funding request, with the provision that the Committee also recommends that the County of Mendocino dedicate a portion of the funds they will receive from opioid settlements to the project in order to offset the Measure B commitment.

Dear Members of the Measure B Oversight Committee,

Shannon Riley will share the progress we have made on the Ukiah Recovery Center Expansion effort at the September 28th Oversight Committee meeting. She will present the changes we have made to our plans, and how those changes impact our construction budget.

I would like to share my observations and concerns with the process as we strive to move forward.

We have spent most of our discussion on funding, and not much time on understanding the impact the expansion will have on serving a large and vulnerable part of the underserved in our county. This seems an incomplete view. You have even heard that the services we provide are not needed or fall short of the community's need. This biased view is also incomplete. It appears the Ukiah Recovery Center Expansion request is the only request that has come before the committee that did not originate with a member of the Oversight Committee. My understanding here may be incomplete, even inaccurate, but I am struggling to understand how you will gain the knowledge you need to make an informed decision. Perhaps the "request for proposal" process will provide the opportunity, but as someone who has been working hard for several years to make the expansion effort a reality, the suggestion seemed like a delay tactic.

I would be remiss if I did not remind you of the following facts:

- If the URC did not have an exemplary record of providing substance use disorder services, we would not have been awarded the BHCIP funding. This was a very competitive funding opportunity.
- The URC expansion effort has been in development since 2017, and as a subcontractor of Partnership Health Plan we are able to provide Drug Medi-Cal services (ASAM 3.1, ASAM 3.2, & Outpatient Treatment) to hundreds of clients each year. The population we serve represents the largest substance use disorder need in Mendocino County. People familiar with Family Dependency Drug Court, Adult Drug Court, and other systems of care designed to help clients regain their self-sufficiency could help you better understand this need.
- Ford Street's commitment to serving this population has existed in this community for over 25 years. Besides providing SUD services and supports, our housing programs are designed to support "new in recovery" families and individuals.
- Subcontracting with capable CBOs can be an advantageous to the county, as Dr. Miller has demonstrated with mental health services. The City of Ukiah and Ford Street have been able to attain state funding in joint applications that provided mutual benefits in the recent past. Investing in a capital improvement effort aimed at serving more SUD clients is to our mutual benefit.
- Several comments were made about Ford Street's financial situation, stating Ford Street did not need the funding. I would be happy to share our annual audits if this is a concern.
- Our county has an opioid crisis that deserves focused attention and solutions. The URC expansion effort could play a significant role in a community developed solution.

Progress made since the June 22 Measure B Oversight Committee meeting

Ford Street has separated the Ukiah Recovery Center Expansion construction project into two phases.

- The first phase is funded by the State of California Behavioral Health Department and includes the construction of the Treatment Pavilion and all site infrastructure required to complete the expansion project. Ford Street has completed all the BHCIP funding requirements and will receive a copy of the contract by mid-October. All grantees are given 45 days to review contract and prepare scope of work and corresponding budget to be included with contract. By early December the contracting process with the State BH Department should be completed.
- 2. Ford Street has submitted the City of Ukiah Planning Permit Application on 9/9/22.
- 3. Ford Street has submitted a request to have the Hope House Remodel building permit that was completed just before pandemic to be reinstated, or if additional changes are required due to building code changes.
- 4. The conceptual budget has been updated, and second phase of the project does not include a "prevailing wage" stipulation.
- 5. Cupples Construction will complete bids on both phases once design is finalized.
