Research has not been done to establish history of this parcel.

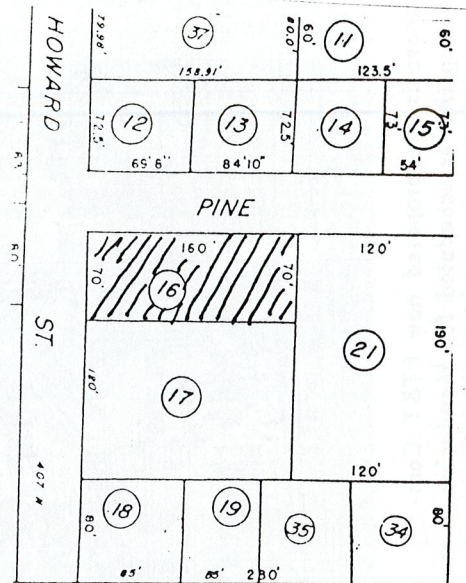
12/23/1924, Jennie F. Anderson of Albion, (husband Albert Anderson) sold this vacant parcel to Octavio Paoli, who also owned 119-150-17 at 10471 Howard St.

12/4/1964, P.T. & T. Co. Were issued a building permit \$13,000.

10/1/1973 - Addition to existing building approved.

8/1.1974: P.T.&T.Co. Foundation poured to enlarge Pac Tel building on Howard St. doubling floor space, changing flat roof to gable roof and 8" shiplap siding on walls to replace stucco.

12.7/1981, Application for a rear one-story building addition at 625 Howard St. approved. With landscaping condition.

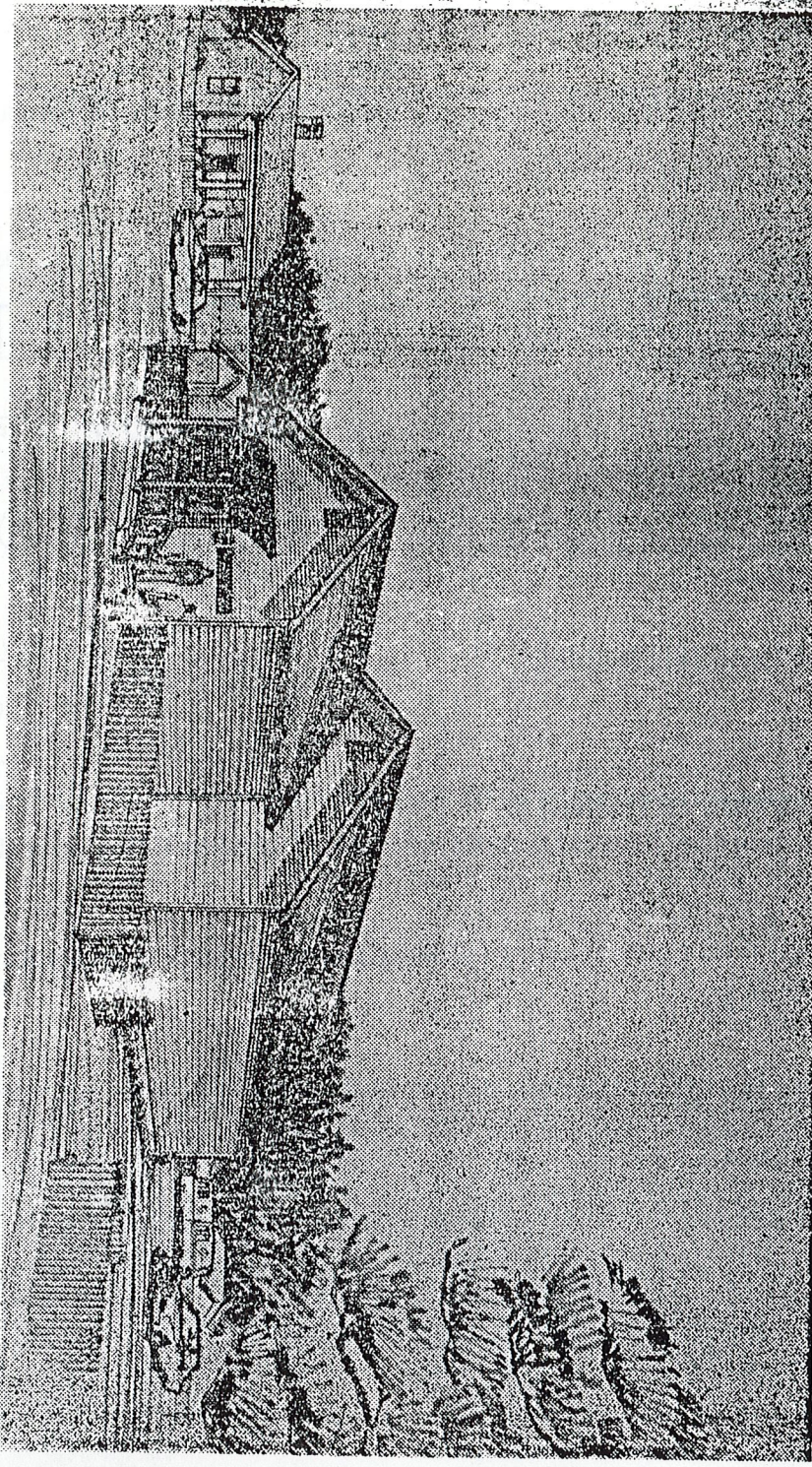

PT&T Plans New Communication Building For Mendocino



Pictured above is the proposed new PT&T Communication Building that is scheduled for Mendocino. Pat Cannole, PT&T area manager stated that "due to increasing demands for service in the community of Mendocino and surrounding area, we must install additional communications equipment to meet this demand. The wood, frame and stucco structure is designed to enhance the scenic beauty of the community and is, to the best of our ability, in keeping with the

Mendocino County Code. Our estimated cost to build the additional 1,000 square feet of building is about \$45,000." The Mendocino Historical Review Board after a public hearing, on the PT&T request to build, voted to approve the request unanimously. Board chairman Hahn complimented the PT&T representative for the fine presentation made at the hearing and for their expressed desire to do what is necessary to maintain the unique architectural character of the community.
