REQUEST: The project involves modifications to an existing wireless communication facility. The scope includes removal of six (6) antennas, seven (7) coaxial cables, one (1) hybrid cable, and six (6) RRUs, and installation of six (6) replacement antennas, three (3) hybrid cables, six (6) RRUs, two (2) microwave dishes, three (3) microwave cables, and one (1) outdoor unit. All work will occur within the existing lease area and will not result in a substantial change to the facility.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION: Categorically Exempt

LOCATION: 9± miles northeast of Laytonville, on the north side of Spyrock Road (CR 323), 4.4± miles northeast of its intersection with U.S. Route 101, located at 3750 Spyrock Road, Laytonville; APN: 056-310-18.

The appeal will be placed on the next available Board agenda and the appellant will be notified of the time and date. Appeals to the Board do not guarantee that the Zoning Administrator's decision will be overturned. In some cases, the Board may not have the legal authority to overturn the decision.
