Success Story

In 2018, an adult client began receiving services from AHM. The client initially struggled with remembering appointments and managing both physical and mental health medications. To support engagement, AHM referred the client to WPC. Their WPC Care Manager worked closely with them to improve medication organization and adherence.

Later, the client experienced a debilitating illness that caused significant memory loss, further complicating their ability to manage care. After returning home from a rehabilitation facility, AHM and WPC resumed their collaborative support. Through consistent engagement, WPC successfully helped the client attend appointments regularly and reduce reliance on hands-on assistance for medication management.

Most recently, after ongoing gentle encouragement and education, the client agreed to begin a long-acting injectable treatment. They are now demonstrating a positive outlook and has developed the ability to advocate for themselves.
