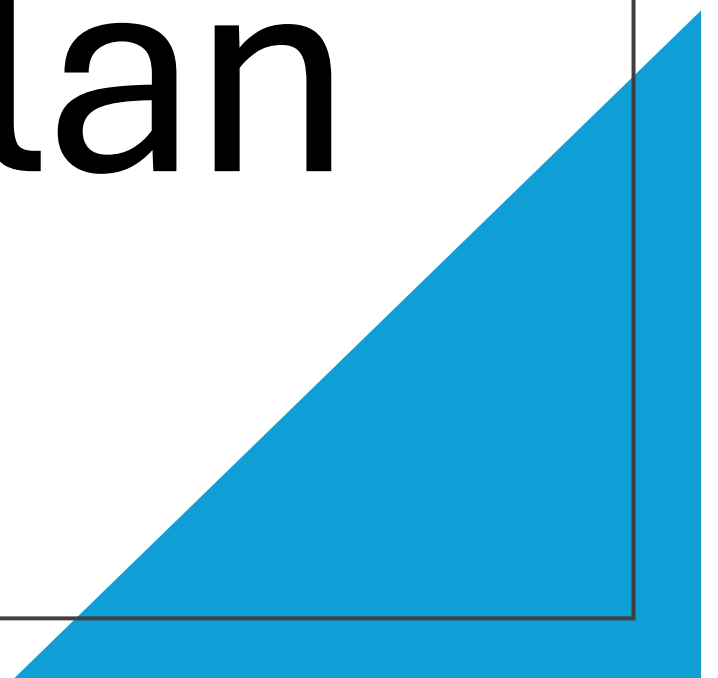

Regulation Changes: Full Service Partnership


- Full Service Partnership will continue to support our clients who have the highest needs for Mental Health Services.
- Full Service Partnership will include SUD services
- Full Service Partnership will be focused on state chosen, evidence based practices listed below (but not limited to):
 - Assertive Community Treatment (ACT)
 - Forensic ACT (FACT)
 - Parent-Child Interaction Therapy (PCIT)
 - High-Fidelity Wraparound (HFW)

Regulation Changes: Indicated Services Only

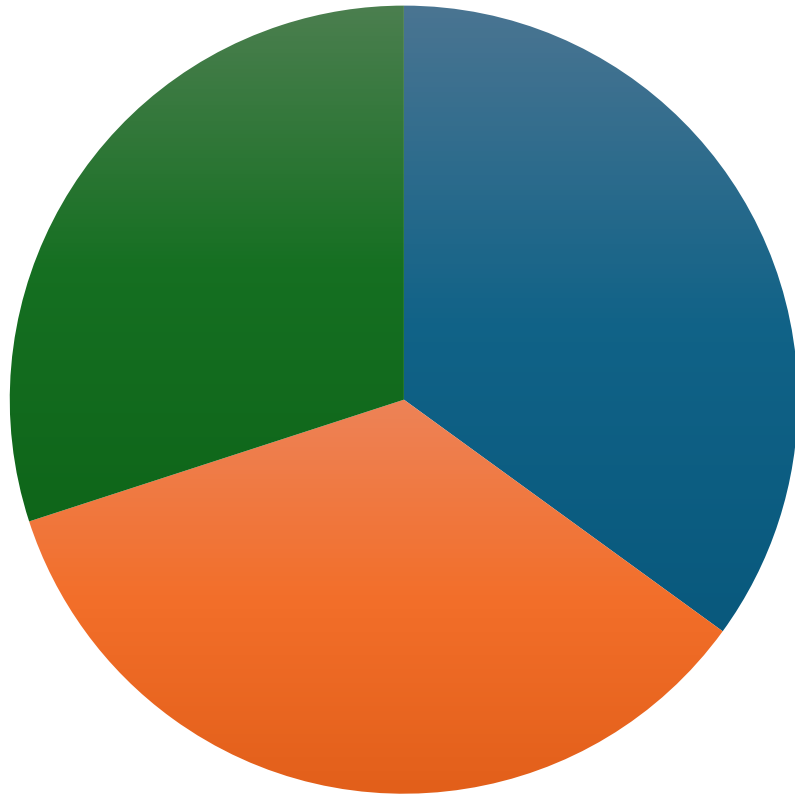


**Infographic is adapted from the Institute of Medicine Continuum of Care Model*

Regulation Changes: Housing Component

- New subcomponent for BHSA
 - Allocated 30% of the overall budget
 - Aim is to reduce Homelessness
 - Focus on housing those who are in encampments

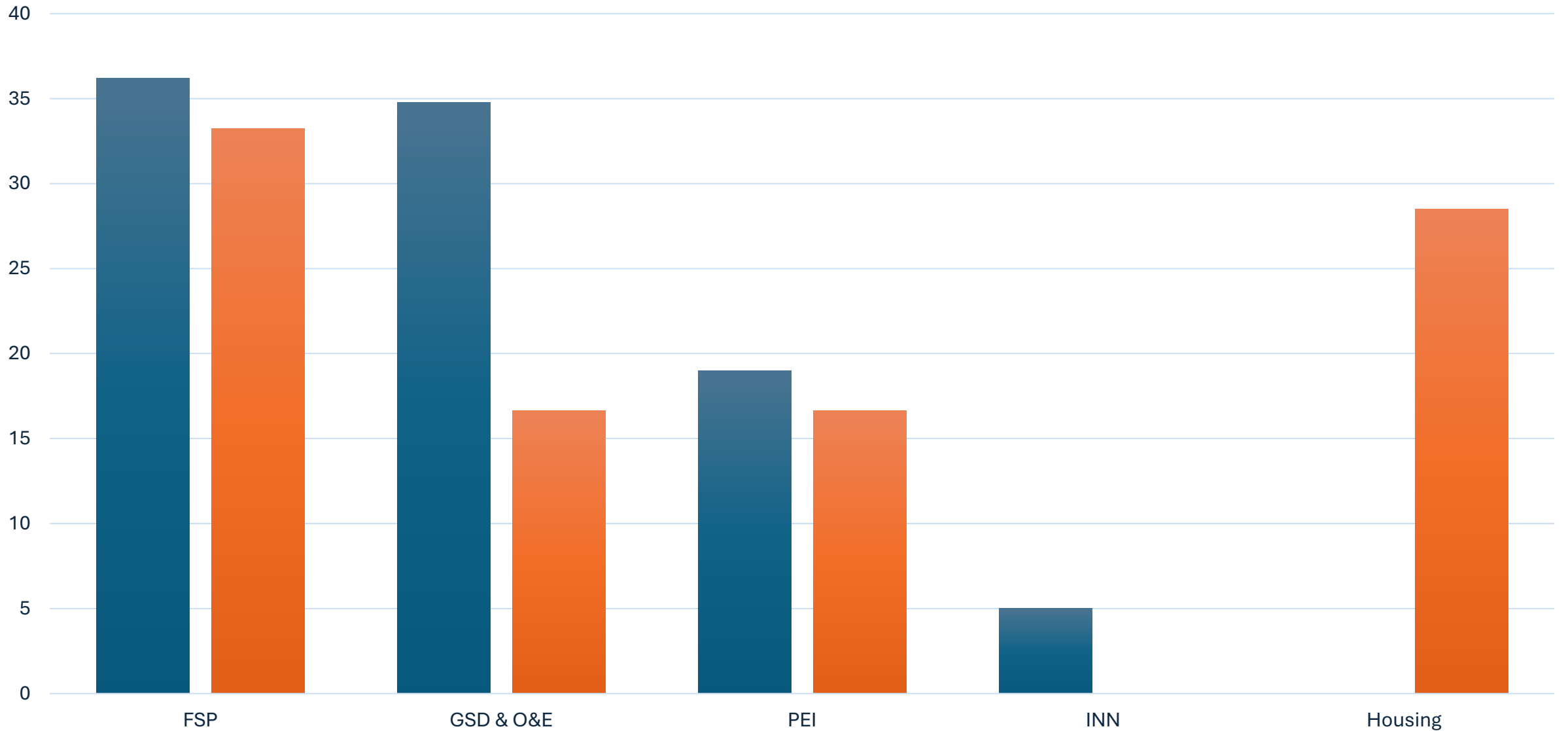


■ FSP ■ BHSS ■ Housing
